CAN I RUN? DCENA BYLAW REQUIREMENTS

- Be a Voting Member in good standing with National ENA, Texas ENA State Council, and DCENA
- Hold a current Registered Nurse (RN) license
- Have attended at least 2 DCENA chapter meetings within the past rolling 12 months
